This deposit covers the number of scouts that you brought to camp in 2011. If additional bunks are desired the reservation fee is \$25.<sup>00</sup> per bunk in addition to the \$250 deposit. This form & the required deposit are due to the Council Office by October 1<sup>st</sup>

**Payment of \$100 (non-refundable) per registered scout is required by March 1<sup>st</sup>. All scouts and leaders must have made the March 1<sup>st</sup> payment and be paid in full by May 15<sup>th</sup> in order to receive the Early Bird Discount. All payments received after that date will be charged a late fee.**

**Out of Council Troops:** If you recruit another unit to attend in 2012, having at least 5 scouts, and who previously has not attended one of our camps, it can be applied to Distinguished Unit Status pricing.

**ALL SITE RESERVATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE CAMPING DEPARTMENT. The Camp Director or Council Program Director MAY reassign your unit to another campsite due to size restrictions or another unit may be assigned into your campsite. This will only occur if there is no separate available site space in camp. The Council reserves the right to close any week of summer camp if the minimum attendance requirement is not met.**
