## *Trailmaster*

A nationally accredited B.S.A. High Adventure Program based out of Camp Tuscarora, Windsor, NY. We are 15 minutes from the Delaware River and are in the foothills of the Catskill Mountains. Camp Tuscarora is located on Rte. 17 between Deposit and Windsor, NY and is 30 min. east of Binghamton, NY. 2012 marks the 59th anniversary of Camp Tuscarora and the 11th year of the Trailmaster program.

## *Trailmaster Program*

The Trailmaster program is designed for youth 13 years and older (Venturers and Scouts) that are looking for something different, fun, and varied. Trailmaster is an exciting program offering a sample of many adventure experiences. A typical week includes mountain biking, climbing/rappelling, team building, two days+ of whitewater (canoe, kayak, tubing, rafting), and a backpacking overnighter. Our experienced camp staff has a top-of-the-line program planned for those who are up to the challenge. The itinerary can be customized to meet the needs of your Troop, Venture Patrol, or Venture Crew. We offer more activity choices for your group; please inquire. Individual Scouts may sign up "provisional" as well. Groups range in size from 6-12 including two adult leaders. ## *Mountain Biking*

We have 22 Mountain Bikes for use at Camp Tuscarora and a trail system that is flat out great, allowing participants to explore the miles of trails found on the 1,000+ acre property of Camp Tuscarora. We also visit Chenango Valley State Park with its miles and miles of trails, from beginner flat to mountain bike competition. With a swimming area with diving boards, snack bar, changing rooms and picnic area, this gem of a park is only 1/2 hour away. Although you may NOT bring your own bike, our bikes are available in three sizes, well maintained, and come with helmet, elbow and knee pads.

## *Delaware River Whitewater Trip*

Here's a chance to arrange a special afternoon trip, overnight or week-long trek for your troop/crew on the nearby Delaware River. Our in camp High Adventure Coordinator can also customize a longer trip (full day, overnight, 3-day, or full week on other local rivers such as the Delaware, Susquehanna, Tioughnioga, or Chenango). Prior arrangements must be made. This is perfect for a troop's older scouts while younger scouts attend our resident camp. Our HA week long fee is \$355.00 per participant plus HA fee of \$85.00 and includes all food, camp supplied equipment, watercraft, shared transportation, etc. Shorter trips will be pro-rated. The Delaware River is a National Scenic River which is run by the National Park Service. The park runs from Hancock (Upper Delaware) to the Delaware Water Gap (Lower Delaware). Wildlife is abundant, especially bald eagles, ducks, deer, etc.



## *Hiking/Backpacking Trips*

If your Troop or Crew is interested in hiking for a day or backpacking overnighters, weekend trips or longer on local trails (Finger Lakes Trail, Catskills, Adirondacks, Northville-Placid Trail, or the Appalachian Trail), contact our Council High Adventure Coordinator, Don O'Brien, who can help you plan your next outing. ## *Fees/Deposits*

The Trailmaster fee is \$355.00 reg. camp fee plus \$85.00 per participant, Scouts & Leaders. Two deep leadership is required for each group which will be supplemented by a Trip Guide from the camp. A deposit of \$50.00 per person is required to hold your reservation, and is non-refundable. See Council policy.
