Supervision:

In addition to your qualified Unit Leaders attending camp, our Cub Scout Camp programs are administered by qualified staff trained by the Boy Scouts of America. All Staff have successfully completed youth protection training along with program training for their staff assignment. The safety of our campers is our first priority. The Cub Scout Camp program emphasizes character development, personal fitness, and good citizenship all while having fun in the outdoors.

Baden-Powell Council Refund Policy:

We understand that situations arise that are beyond anyone's control that may prevent a Scout from attending camp at the last minute or cause a Scout to leave camp before the end of his session. Scouts who are unable to attend camp or leave camp for any reason other than disciplinary will receive a refund less a \$125.00 cancellation/service fee. This fee will help cover the supplies, food and staff that were purchased and made available based on camp attendance. Thank you for your understanding.

Other Items:

Each Scout will receive one T-shirt with paid registration that must be worn at camp at all times as it is a security feature. Each Scout must also wear shoes or sneakers while at camp— no sandals or open toed shoes are allowed.

Medical Attention— Certified Medical Personnel are on duty at each camp. Each boy must have a yearly physical which will be turned in at registration. Our camps have working agreements with local hospitals, ambulances, and a physician is on call at all times.

Resident Camp Registration Form Instructions

- Print only please.
 - Fill out a SEPARATE FORM for each individual camp your Pack is attending.
 - Payment must accompany the registration form.
 - No other forms will be accepted for registration.
 - Your Pack can sign up for a specific Campsite, however, we cannot guarantee that site as multiple units may request it, or size considerations may have to be taken into account. There is a \$250 deposit fee which will be applied towards your total camp fee. There is a reservation form included with this guide. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. You will be contacted if space in the program you request is not available. You may monitor campsite availability by calling council or checking the website for the week you are interested in attending.
 - Ranks for dens formed at summer camp will be based on what the Scout will be in September, as he should have finished the requirements for his current rank by the time camp is held. Scouts will be kept with other scouts of the same or similar rank in their Pack.
 - Financial Aid: A campership form must be completely filled out, properly signed by the unit leader and returned by April 1. Please refer to the Leader's Guide to Summer Camping for complete details and a copy of this form. Please include proper documentation of any campership awarded in this column with payment, and be sure to bring campership letters along with you to camp check-in.
 - \$ Due after discounts: This column should show the total fee after any financial aid or discounts have been applied.
 - Subtract an additional \$25 from *each* Scout's camp fee if the money and registration form are turned in to the office by March 16, 2012.
 - Total: This column should reflect the total fees after all discounts and financial assistance are applied.
 - ***Please make sure every Scout's family is aware of the refund policy before registering them for camp. Full details are available in the Leader's Guide, on the website or by calling the office.***
 - Incomplete forms will be returned to the Pack.
 - BSA requires that we account for every Scout who is listed on this reservation form. If you do not bring a note from the parent for any Scout who is not with the Pack at check-in, your whole Pack will be held at the Administration area until a parent can be reached to verify the location of the missing Scout. Please make sure that the phone number listed is current as the office is closed during check-in and Pack membership rosters are not available. This is designed to eliminate possible communication problems with times, dates, meeting places etc. that might result in a Scout missing camp.
- Reservation forms must be at Council on May 18, 2012 to qualify for listed prices.
