“Scouting for Food” is Scouting’s community stewardship project aimed at addressing the problems of hunger in the community in which we live and work.

Who: All units in the Baden-Powell Council

What: Scouting for Food is a food collection effort carried out by Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Venturers from your community. Scouts distribute food drive donation requests through a designated area and then return to collect the plastic grocery bags filled with donated food. The bags are collected and carried to local food pantries, churches, shelters for the homeless, and other local agencies that feed the needy.

Where: In your local community. Units decide what pantry they would like to donate to

When: Bag distribution is on March 10th and bag collection is on March 17th
