

Is any Special Equipment Needed?

An equipment list will be sent to each scout before the start of the course. Youth who participate in an active outdoor program probably already have the necessary personal equipment. An official Boy Scout or Venturing uniform is required. Each participant should make sure that badges and insignia are properly placed and that the uniform is worn correctly.

What About Medical Forms?

Parts A,B, and C of the BSA medical form are required and must be signed by a physician. Over-the-counter medication forms are available on the Council website.

Space is limited. If you are thinking about sending a Scout to NYLT, please sign them up early to reserve a place.

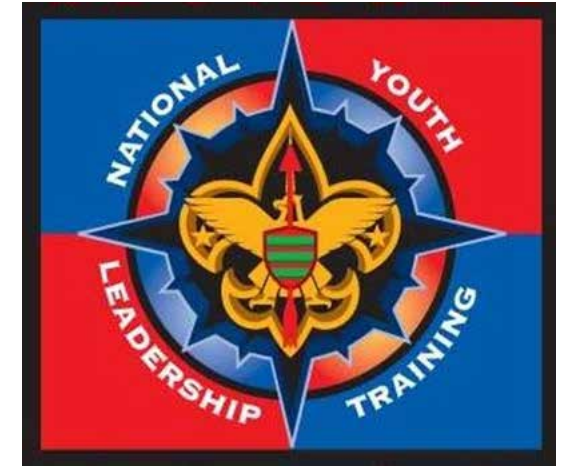
