

What to Bring to Camp (Troop Gear)

Equipment:

- Troop Records Book
- Patrol Flag
- Unit Flags
- Country Flags (American, Foreign)
- Paper, Pencils, Pens, Clipboards, etc...
- Troop Advancement Chart
- Patrol Cooking Equipment
- Dutch Ovens
- Merit Badge Application Cards
- Thumb Tacks
- Battery Powered Alarm Clock
- Lanterns, Stoves (Propane)

Camp Fire & Program Materials:

- Troop Song Book
- Skit & Presentation Supplies
- Ceremony Equipment

First Aid Kit:

Each unit is encouraged to bring their own first aid kit and supplies.

Completed Medical Forms:

Scouts cannot be admitted into camp without a completed medical form with the appropriate physician signature, parent/guardian signature, and vaccination dates.

Advancement:

Merit Badge pamphlets, BSA Handbooks, pens, pencils, & paper. Partial Blue Cards. Merit Badge pre-requisite work (Started or Completed)

Special Optional Items:

Flashlight, Fishing Gear, Camera & Film or Digital Camera, Insect Repellent, Musical Instrument, Bible, Testament or Prayer Book, Spending Money, Alarm Clock (battery powered), Pillow. **Note:** Scouts interested in taking those Merit Badges offered at the waterfront (swimming, lifesaving, rowing, canoeing) or the First Year Camper & BSA Lifeguard Training should bring long trousers, a long sleeved button down shirt, and a pair of old sneakers. They will use these clothes for rapid undress and/or emergency swim requirements and should plan to get them wet. For this reason, old clothing is suggested. Mask, Fins, and Snorkels should be brought for BSA Snorkel and/or Intro to SCUBA.

What to Leave at Home

Firearms, Ammunition, Fireworks, Sheath Knives, Camouflage & Military Uniforms/clothing, Valuables, Radio/Boom Boxes, CD players, Motorized or Remote Controlled Toys, Personal CB Radios, Aerosol Spray Cans of any type with the exception of insect repellent, Pets.

Note: Unfortunately, even at scout camp, losses occur. For self protection, valuables that are merely 'creature comforts' (radios, cell phones, etc...) should be left at home. We carry no insurance on personal items.
