## Winter Unit 5

The Center Lodge is shared with all units renting lean-to's in the site. The site is primitive in nature; there is no running water or electricity. Water is available via a hand pump (currently out of service 3/1/14 for repairs), and although tested yearly, should be treated before drinking. Do not bathe or wash dishes under the pump as this will result in contamination of the well. Troop trailers ARE NOT permitted in the site. Vehicle traffic is highly discouraged as the conditons are usually muddy and even a four-wheel drive vehicle can get stuck. Please park all vehciles and trailers in the clearing above the site. Cell service is limited at best. This unit will provide an excellent primitive setting for teaching many Scouting and wilderness skills. Our Wilderness Survival class is conducted on this site during summer camp. This is a carry-in, carry-out campsite. A Scout is clean.
