PRE - REGISTRATION

Please Pre-register by September 24th. **NO REGISTRATIONS AFTER September 24th!**

CHECK IN

Please register at the pavilion in the main parking lot between 8:30 - 9:00am on Saturday.

CHECK OUT

Come to Campmaster Building for check out, one of the event staff will check your camp site when your unit is ready to leave.

CAMPING and PARKING

We will be camping in Winter Unit Sites 2-4 and Susquenango (First Come, First Serve to Council Camping Department) and Summer Units if interested. 1 Vehicle per unit will be allowed in sites.

ALL OTHER VEHICLES WILL BE PARKED IN MAIN CAMP PARKING LOT.

CAMPFIRES

Saturday evening campfire will include skits, songs, and cheers from Dens and Staff.

LEADERSHIP

Two-deep leadership is required for each den. In most cases, the Webelos Scout will be under the supervision of their parent or guardian. It is essential that each Webelos Scout be under the supervision of a parent-approved adult ([Guide to Safe Scouting](#)). If a parent cannot attend, arrangements must be made for another

youth's parent (not the Webelos den leader) or another adult to be a substitute. No parent should be responsible for more than one youth other than their own.

MEALS

Saturday Lunch, Saturday Dinner, and Sunday Breakfast are provided in the Dining Hall.

REST ROOMS

Site Lanterns will be available during the event as well as the shower house, and dining hall restrooms.

RELIGIOUS SERVICE

A non denominational service will be held on Sunday morning at 9:15am. Event Closing will immediately follow.

EVENTS

All materials will be provided at each station, please bring your Webelos Handbooks.

- First Aid
- Fire Building
- Cooking
- Plant and Animal Identification

GENERAL RULES

1. At all times, follow the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
2. Stay with your den during the events and with your pack at all other times. Use the buddy system.
3. If it isn't yours, don't touch it.
4. Stay away from the waterfront.
5. Don't mess with any wildlife.
6. If you are not female, stay out of the women's restrooms.
7. Keep your campsite clean at all times. Dispose of trash properly.
8. Observe lights out and silence in the camp.
9. If someone gets hurt, let an adult know and have them get our medical team over to take care of the injured person. Don't move them unless they are in danger staying where they are.
10. No vehicles in the camping area.
11. No ground fires. No liquid fuel. Propane is okay; Webelos Scouts shall not handle propane fuel.
12. All fires must be in pits, raised off the ground. All ash must be removed from the site - not placed in the trashcans.
13. Never leave your campfire unattended. Put out all fires before going to bed.
14. Webelos Scouts will not be allowed to handle axes or hatchets. Saws are to have blade guards.
15. No sheath knives, No firearms, No BB guns, No fireworks, or No slingshots are permitted.
16. If your group wishes not to camp, you will still be assigned a campsite. The same rules apply as if you were staying the night.
17. After all of the above, HAVE FUN IN SPITE OF ALL THE RULES!

WHAT TO BRING

Personal gear:

- Bed roll, or sleeping bag
- Jacket, raingear, hat
- Extra change of clothes
- Camp cup
- Personal items
- Field uniform (Webelos Scout uniform) and activity uniform (Scout t-shirt)
- Webelos Handbook
- Hand sanitizer
- Folding chairs
- BSA Health and Medical form Parts A&B for every participant -- everyone onsite (parents too)

Den gear:

- Tents with ground cloth (If not staying in a Winter Unit)
- First-aid kit (required - one per pack is acceptable)
- Trash bags
