

## National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)

is an experiential learning opportunity to develop skills for life. The program is run by trained and high-quality youth, under the mentorship of experienced adults. The program teaches participants the concepts of what a leader must BE, what a leader must KNOW, and what a leader must DO.



### Eligibility to participate:

Youth registered in any of the BSA Scouting programs (Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts, and Exploring) and that are 13-20 years old. Scouts in the Scouts BSA program must also have earned a minimum of the First Class rank.

### Benefits:

#### *To youth and units*

The NYLT Program offers the opportunity to youth to develop individually in several ways. Parents and Unit Leaders should consider the overall “readiness” of each youth to participate in the Program to maximize this opportunity for themselves and for their Unit. Youth can grow in confidence, leadership skills, teaching and presentation skills, as well as in values-based areas like ethics, respect, and energy for the Scouting program.

Youth may also earn opportunities to enhance their growth through selections to serve on the youth staff team for the course and even to attend the NYLT Leadership Academy in the Washington, DC area.

Units can benefit from a youth’s experience at NYLT as well. Youth returning from the Program can bring the skills, experiences, and new ideas back to their Unit. This is even more likely to occur if they are able to attend with peers from their unit, supporting them to continue to make those connections.

## Wood Badge and Unit Leader Connections

The NYLT program is closely aligned with the Wood Badge program, with many similar components. We encourage all adult leaders to take the Wood Badge program to enhance the benefits to units.

Youth participants of NYLT are encouraged throughout the week to develop personal and unit goals—unit leaders are encouraged to promote this concept and to follow up with youth after they return to the units after the program.

Unit leaders are also encouraged to reach out to the Course Director and other adult leaders on NYLT regarding ways to encourage and mentor youth with the skills learned.

The program is also open for observation throughout the week.

### Financial Assistance

Council has some assistance through the campership applications—please remember that these are due by April 1st.

Council also offers a \$30.00 discount for youth participants who attend a second week of camp programs.

Council also will discount participant fees if units have more than one youth attend NYLT.

Units are encouraged to build support for youth participation into their unit budgets.
