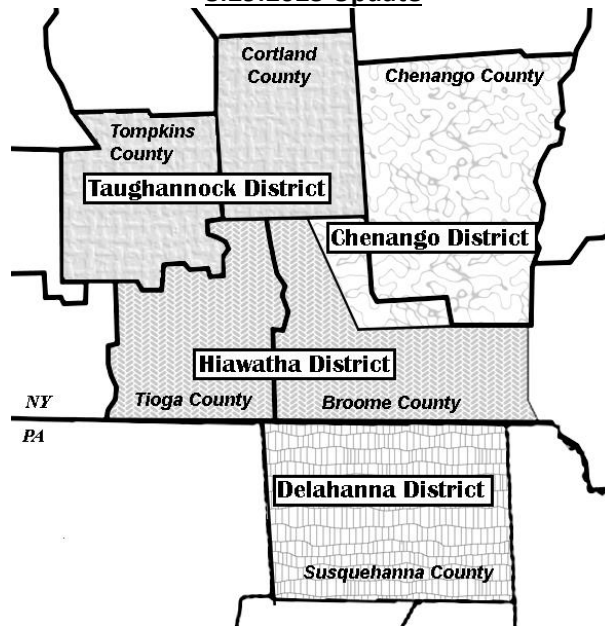

WHO
